PROGRAMS OFFERED

The Pine Burr Area Council is chartered by the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America to provide support to local Scouting programs in seventeen counties in South Mississippi. We provide resources to programs at 121 local community partner organizations. 3652 youth and adults are members of these programs.



Cub Scouting is a fun family-oriented program for boys and girls in kindergarten through fifth grade. These programs are not co-ed, but can be operated as a family pack with boy dens and girl dens in the same pack or you can have all boy packs or all girl packs.



Scouts BSA is a character development program designed to teach boys and girls how to be leaders. This program is for boys and girls in sixth through twelfth grades. These are two separate programs, a troop for boys and one for girls. They are not co-ed programs, but can be sponsored by the same chartering organization.



Venturing is a character development program for young men and women who are 14 through 20 years of age. This can be a co-ed program or it can be an all boys crew or all girls crew.



Exploring is a career education and job skills program for young men and women who are at least 14 and not yet 21 years of age. This can be a co-ed program or it can be an all boys post or all girls post.


