



FOUNDER'S AWARD NOMINATION

Introduced at the 1981 National Order of the Arrow Conference, the Founder's Award recognizes Arrowmen who have given outstanding service to their lodge. The award is reserved for an Arrowman who demonstrates that he or she personifies the spirit of selfless service, as advocated by founder E. Urner Goodman and co-founder Carroll A. Edson.

Ti'ak Lodge may petition the national Order of the Arrow committee to present two awards annually. At least one of the two awards must be to a youth under the age of 21. Any Order of the Arrow member in good standing with Ti'ak Lodge #404 may submit a recommendation form for the Founder's Award, but self-nomination is prohibited.
